2. Briefly describe your vision for Huntersville in the next 10 to 15 years. What factors during that time will shape the growth of our community?
My vision is growth under direction, with infrastructure (roads) to support that growth.
A key factor will be the willingness of residents and business owners to contribute to the solutions. That will include increased taxes. Another will be the ability of the town to find alternative ways to control growth in the face of the recent bill from Raleigh.
3. With rapid development occurring in Huntersville and the surrounding area, the character and growth patterns of our community are changing rapidly. Please discuss briefly any problems that you perceive, anything that you would like to change, and/or anything you find particularly appropriate to Huntersville.
I believe a greater focus on the impact of development on infrastructure will be necessary. The greatest perceived negative reaction of residents is congestion. Some years ago some of us went to Cary on a fact finding mission. We learned how they address congestion - including a traffic control center. With or without managed lanes, this town will need to take control of its own future.
