To assist the Board of Commissioners in making appointments to the Land Development Ordinances Advisory Board ("Advisory Board"), please respond briefly to the following questions. There is no right or wrong answer. Your responses will provide a framework for discussion with the Mayor and Commissioners.

Overview: The Advisory Board consists of eight (8) voting members appointed by the Board of Commissioners. The Regular membership shall consist of six (6) members who reside within the corporate limits, or extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction ("ETJ").

1. Please describe the areas of community service in which you have participated, in Huntersville or elsewhere.

As noted above I served on the Huntersville Town Board for two terms and am very familiar with the complexity of ordinance creation, enforcement, and impact assessments. In addition to my work for the town I have also been an Assistant Scout Master for Troop 19, Huntersville Presbyterian Church, since 2004.

2. Briefly describe your vision for Huntersville in the next 10 to 15 years. What factors during that time will shape the growth of our community?

There is always a balance required between growth, both commercial and residential, and the ability to maintain adequate infrastructure. That infrastructure extends beyond roads, water/waste, and power to other quality of life factors such as parks and recreation. Beyond the view of creating win/win scenario's for existing residents and businesses, when considering ordinances, we must focus on the efficacy of the ordinances to promote the desired outcomes.

3. With rapid development occurring in Huntersville and the surrounding area, the character and growth patterns of our community are changing rapidly. Please discuss briefly any problems that you perceive, anything that you would like to change, and/or anything you find particularly appropriate to Huntersville.

As I noted above the key areas that are regularly of concern include transportation impacts, consistency of the development with existing/neighbor development, and the overall effect on quality of life.

A strong balance must be maintained be the rights of residents, and current businesses, against Huntersville's goals for managing, and attracting growth components that will help us retain the towns unique character.
