The Town of Huntersville has received a petition for a voluntary, non-contiguous annexation of certain property located along Poplar Tent Road (see the enclosed map). The purpose of this letter is to give the required sixty-day (60) notice under the Annexation or Sphere of Influence Agreement by and between the Town of Huntersville and the Town of Davidson.

This voluntary annexation is a non-contiguous annexation pursuant to the provisions of North Carolina General Statute 160A-58, et seq.




WAIVER OF NOTICE
